## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4187

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 5805 (MCL 600.5805), as amended by 1988 PA 115.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5805. (1) A person shall not bring or maintain an
- 2 action to recover damages for injuries to persons or property
- 3 unless, after the claim first accrued to the plaintiff or to
- 4 someone through whom the plaintiff claims, the action is com-
- 5 menced within the periods of time prescribed by this section.
- **6** (2) The period of limitations is 2 years for an action
- 7 charging assault, battery, or false imprisonment.
- 8 (3) THE PERIOD OF LIMITATIONS IS 5 YEARS FOR AN ACTION
- 9 CHARGING ASSAULT OR BATTERY BROUGHT BY A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN
- 10 ASSAULTED OR BATTERED BY HIS OR HER SPOUSE OR FORMER SPOUSE, AN

- 1 INDIVIDUAL WITH WHOM HE OR SHE HAS HAD A CHILD IN COMMON, OR A

- 13 malpractice.
- 14 (6)  $\overline{(5)}$  The period of limitations is 2 years for an action
- 15 against a sheriff charging misconduct or neglect of office by the
- 16 sheriff or the sheriff's deputies.
- 17 (7)  $\overline{(6)}$  The period of limitations is 2 years after the
- 18 expiration of the year for which a constable was elected for
- 19 actions based on the constable's negligence or misconduct as
- 20 constable.
- 21 (8)  $\overline{(7)}$  The period of limitations is 1 year for an action
- 22 charging libel or slander.
- 23 (9)  $\overline{(8)}$  The period of limitations is 3 years after the
- 24 time of the death or injury for all other actions to recover dam-
- 25 ages for the death of a person, or for injury to a person or
- 26 property.
