SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4752

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 203 (MCL 436.1203).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 203. (1) Except as provided in this section and sec-
- 2 tion 301, a sale, delivery, or importation of alcoholic liquor,
- 3 including alcoholic liquor for personal use, shall not be made in
- 4 this state unless the sale, delivery, or importation is made by
- 5 the commission, the commission's authorized agent or distributor,
- 6 an authorized distribution agent approved by order of the commis-
- 7 sion, a person licensed by the commission, or by prior written
- 8 order of the commission.
- 9 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (1), THE SALE, DELIVERY, OR
- 10 IMPORTATION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO,
- 11 THE SALE, DELIVERY, OR IMPORTATION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TRANSACTED

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- 1 OR CAUSED TO BE TRANSACTED BY MEANS OF ANY MAIL ORDER, INTERNET,
- 2 TELEPHONE, COMPUTER, DEVICE, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC MEANS. SUBJECT
- 3 TO SUBSECTION (3), IF A RETAIL SALE, DELIVERY, OR IMPORTATION OF
- 4 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR OCCURS BY ANY SUCH MEANS, THE RETAILER MUST
- 5 COMPLY WITH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) BE APPROPRIATELY LICENSED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE.
- 7 (B) PAY ANY APPLICABLE TAXES TO THE COMMISSION.
- 8 (C) COMPLY WITH ALL PROHIBITIONS OF THE LAWS OF THIS STATE
- 9 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SALES TO MINORS.
- 10 (D) VERIFY THE AGE OF THE INDIVIDUAL PLACING THE ORDER BY
- 11 OBTAINING FROM HIM OR HER AN AFFIRMATION THAT HE OR SHE IS OF LEGAL
- 12 AGE TO PURCHASE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR. THE PERSON RECEIVING AND
- 13 ACCEPTING THE ORDER SHALL RECORD THE NAME, ADDRESS, DATE OF BIRTH,
- 14 AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE PERSON PLACING THE ORDER ON THE ORDER
- 15 FORM OR OTHER VERIFIABLE RECORD OF A TYPE AND GENERATED IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION.
- 16 (E) UPON REQUEST OF THE COMMISSION, MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE
- 17 COMMISSION ANY DOCUMENT USED TO VERIFY THE AGE OF THE INDIVIDUAL
- 18 ORDERING THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FROM THE RETAIL SELLER.
- 19 (F) STAMP, PRINT, OR LABEL ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE SHIPPING
- 20 CONTAINER LANGUAGE THAT CLEARLY ESTABLISHES IN A PROMINENT FASH-
- 21 ION THAT THE PACKAGE CONTAINS ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND THAT THE
- 22 RECIPIENT AT THE TIME OF THE DELIVERY IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE IDENTIFICATION VERIFYING HIS OR
- 23 HER AGE ALONG WITH A SIGNATURE.
- 24 (G) PLACE A LABEL ON THE TOP PANEL OF THE SHIPPING CONTAINER
- 25 CONTAINING THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL PLACING THE ORDER AND THE NAME OF
- 26 THE DESIGNATED RECIPIENT, IF ANY.

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- 1 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2), IN THE CASE OF A RETAIL
- 2 SALE, DELIVERY, OR IMPORTATION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR OCCURRING BY
- 3 ANY MEANS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON TAKING THE ORDER
- 4 ON BEHALF OF THE RETAILER MUST COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (2)(C)
- 5 THROUGH (G).
- 6 (4) THE PERSON WHO DELIVERS THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR SHALL
- 7 VERIFY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL ACCEPTING DELIVERY IS OF LEGAL AGE AND IS
- 8 EITHER THE INDIVIDUAL WHO PLACED THE ORDER OR THE DESIGNATED
- 9 RECIPIENT RESIDING AT THE SAME ADDRESS OR IS OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED THROUGH A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT BY THE COMMISSION TO RECEIVE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR UNDER THIS SECTION. IF THE DELIVERY PERSON,
- 10 AFTER A DILIGENT INQUIRY, DETERMINES THAT THE PURCHASER OR DESIG-
- 11 NATED RECIPIENT IS NOT OF LEGAL AGE, THE DELIVERY PERSON SHALL
- 12 RETURN THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO THE RETAILER. A DELIVERY PERSON
- 13 WHO RETURNS ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO THE RETAILER DUE TO INABILITY TO
- 14 OBTAIN THE PURCHASER'S OR DESIGNATED RECIPIENT'S LEGAL AGE IS NOT
- 15 LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES SUFFERED BY THE PURCHASER OR RETAILER.
- 16 (5) All spirits for sale, use, storage, or distribution in
- 17 this state, shall originally be purchased by and imported into
- 18 the state by the commission, or by prior written authority of the
- 19 commission.
- **20** (6) This section shall DOES not apply in the case of an
- 21 alcoholic liquor brought into this state for personal or house-
- 22 hold use in an amount permitted by federal law by a person of
- 23 legal age to purchase alcoholic liquor at the time of reentry
- 24 into this state from without the territorial limits of the United
- 25 States if the person has been outside the territorial limits of
- 26 the United States for more than 48 hours and has not brought

- 3 (7) (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a A person who is
- 4 of legal age to purchase alcoholic liquor may import from
- 5 another state for that person's personal use not more than 312
- 6 ounces of alcoholic liquor that contains less than 21% alcohol by
- 7 volume DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING IN RELATION TO
- 8 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR THAT CONTAINS LESS THAN 21% ALCO-
- 9 HOL BY VOLUME:
- 10 (A) PERSONALLY TRANSPORT FROM ANOTHER STATE, ONCE IN A
- 11 24-HOUR PERIOD, NOT MORE THAN 312 OUNCES OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR THAT PERSON'S PERSONAL
- 12 USE, NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (1).
- 13 (B) SHIP OR IMPORT FROM ANOTHER STATE ALCOHOLIC
- 14 LIQUOR FOR THAT PERSON'S PERSONAL USE SO LONG AS THAT PERSONAL
- 15 IMPORTATION IS DONE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (1).
- 16 (8) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 17 (A) "COMPUTER" MEANS ANY CONNECTED, DIRECTLY INTEROPERABLE
- 18 OR INTERACTIVE DEVICE, EQUIPMENT, OR FACILITY THAT USES A COM-
- 19 PUTER PROGRAM OR OTHER INSTRUCTIONS TO PERFORM SPECIFIC OPERA-
- 20 TIONS INCLUDING LOGICAL, ARITHMETIC, OR MEMORY FUNCTIONS WITH OR
- 21 ON COMPUTER DATA OR A COMPUTER PROGRAM AND THAT CAN STORE,
- 22 RETRIEVE, ALTER, OR COMMUNICATE THE RESULTS OF THE OPERATIONS TO
- 23 A PERSON, COMPUTER PROGRAM, COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COM-
- 24 PUTER NETWORK.
- 25 (B) "COMPUTER NETWORK" MEANS THE INTERCONNECTION OF HARDWIRE
- 26 OR WIRELESS COMMUNICATION LINES WITH A COMPUTER THROUGH REMOTE

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- 1 TERMINALS, OR A COMPLEX CONSISTING OF 2 OR MORE INTERCONNECTED
- 2 COMPUTERS.
- 3 (C) "COMPUTER PROGRAM" MEANS A SERIES OF INTERNAL OR EXTER-
- 4 NAL INSTRUCTIONS COMMUNICATED IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO A COMPUTER
- 5 THAT DIRECTS THE FUNCTIONING OF A COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR
- 6 COMPUTER NETWORK IN A MANNER DESIGNED TO PROVIDE OR PRODUCE PRO-
- 7 DUCTS OR RESULTS FROM THE COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER
- 8 NETWORK.
- 9 (D) "COMPUTER SYSTEM" MEANS A SET OF RELATED, CONNECTED OR
- 10 UNCONNECTED, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, DEVICES, SOFTWARE, OR HARDWARE.
- 11 (E) "DEVICE" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, AN ELECTRONIC,
- 12 MAGNETIC, ELECTROCHEMICAL, BIOCHEMICAL, HYDRAULIC, OPTICAL, OR
- 13 ORGANIC OBJECT THAT PERFORMS INPUT, OUTPUT, OR STORAGE FUNCTIONS
- 14 BY THE MANIPULATION OF ELECTRONIC, MAGNETIC, OR OTHER IMPULSES.
- 15 (F) "DILIGENT INQUIRY" MEANS A DILIGENT GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO
- 16 DETERMINE THE AGE OF A PERSON, WHICH INCLUDES AT LEAST AN EXAMI-
- 17 NATION OF AN OFFICIAL MICHIGAN OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE,
- 18 AN OFFICIAL MICHIGAN PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR ANY OTHER
- 19 BONA FIDE PICTURE IDENTIFICATION WHICH ESTABLISHES THE IDENTITY
- 20 AND AGE OF THE PERSON.
