# SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5134

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending sections 3805 and 4701 (MCL 600.3805 and 600.4701), section 4701 as amended by 2000 PA 184.

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3805. (1) The attorney general of the state of
- 2 Michigan OR the prosecuting attorney or any citizen of the
- 3 county may maintain an action for equitable relief in the
- 4 name of the state of Michigan, upon the relation of such THE
- 5 attorney general, prosecuting attorney, or citizen to abate
- 6 said THE nuisance and to perpetually enjoin any person, his A
- 7 PERSON OR HIS OR HER servant, agent, or employee, who shall own,
- 8 lease, conduct or maintain such OWNS, LEASES, CONDUCTS, OR
- 9 MAINTAINS A building, vehicle, boat, aircraft, or place —,
- 10 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 3801 from permitting or suffering such

- 1 THAT building, vehicle, boat, or aircraft or place owned, leased,
- 2 conducted, or maintained by him OR HER, or any other building,
- 3 vehicle, boat, aircraft or place conducted or maintained by him
- 4 OR HER, to be used for any of the purposes PROSCRIBED, or by any
- 5 of the persons set forth DESCRIBED, in section 3801 , or for
- 6 any of the acts enumerated in said section 3801. When the
- 7 injunction has been granted, it shall be binding on the defendant
- 8 throughout the judicial circuit in which it was issued.

- 7 (f) "Substituted proceeds of a crime" means any property
- 8 obtained or any gain realized by the sale or exchange of proceeds
- 9 of a crime.
