SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5187

A bill to amend 1979 PA 53, entitled

"An act to prohibit access to computers, computer systems, and computer networks for certain fraudulent purposes; to prohibit intentional and unauthorized access, alteration, damage, and destruction of computers, computer systems, computer networks, computer software programs, and data; and to prescribe penalties,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 752.792), as amended by 1996 PA 326.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) "Access" means to instruct, communicate with,
- 2 store data in, retrieve or intercept data from, or otherwise use
- 3 the resources of a computer program, computer, computer system,
- 4 or computer network.
- 5 (2) "Aggregate amount" means any direct or indirect loss
- 6 incurred by a victim OR GROUP OF VICTIMS including, but not
- 7 limited to, the value of any money, property or service lost,
- 8 stolen, or rendered unrecoverable by the offense, or any actual

- 1 expenditure incurred by the victim OR GROUP OF VICTIMS to verify
- 2 that a computer program, computer, computer system, or computer
- 3 network was not altered, acquired, damaged, deleted, disrupted,
- 4 or destroyed by the access. THE DIRECT OR INDIRECT LOSSES
- 5 INCURRED IN SEPARATE INCIDENTS PURSUANT TO A SCHEME OR COURSE OF
- 6 CONDUCT WITHIN ANY 12-MONTH PERIOD MAY BE AGGREGATED TO DETERMINE
- 7 THE TOTAL VALUE OF THE LOSS INVOLVED IN THE VIOLATION OF THIS
- 8 ACT.
- 9 (3) "Computer" means any connected, directly interoperable
- 10 or interactive device, equipment, or facility that uses a com-
- 11 puter program or other instructions to perform specific opera-
- 12 tions including logical, arithmetic, or memory functions with or
- 13 on computer data or a computer program and that can store,
- 14 retrieve, alter, or communicate the results of the operations to

- 17 (4) "Computer network" means the interconnection of hardwire
- 18 or wireless communication lines with a computer through remote
- 19 terminals, or a complex consisting of 2 or more interconnected

- 21 (5) "Computer program" means a series of internal or exter-
- 22 nal instructions communicated in a form acceptable to a computer
- 23 that directs the functioning of a computer, computer system, or
- 24 computer network in a manner designed to provide or produce pro-
- 25 ducts or results from the computer, computer system, or computer
