

**REPRINT
SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 5292**

(As passed the House, March 1, 2000)

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending section 9208 (MCL 333.9208).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 9208. (1) A parent, guardian, or person in loco paren-
2 tis applying to have a child registered for the first time in a
3 school in this state AND, BEGINNING IN 2002-2003, A PARENT,
4 GUARDIAN, OR PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS OF A CHILD ENTERING THE
5 SIXTH GRADE, shall present to school officials, at the time of
6 registration or not later than the first day of school, a certif-
7 icate of immunization or statement of exemption under section
8 9215.

9 (2) A teacher or principal shall not permit a child to enter
10 or attend school unless a certificate indicating that a minimum
11 of 1 dose of an immunizing agent against each of the diseases

1 specified by the department has been received and certified to by
2 a health professional or local health department. A parent,
3 guardian, or person in loco parentis having a child registered
4 with only these minimum doses of immunizing agents shall present
5 an updated certificate of immunization within 4 months after ini-
6 tial attendance showing that the immunizations have been com-
7 pleted as prescribed by the department.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
9 effect unless all of the following bills of the 90th Legislature
10 are enacted into law:
