

**HB 5410, As Passed Senate, December 14, 2000**

February 22, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Sanborn, Law, Shulman, Kukuk, LaSata, Baird, Minore, Schermesser, Koetje, Voorhees, Hart, Richner, Switalski and Faunce and referred to the Committee on Family and Civil Law.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 289, entitled

"An act to implement, clarify, and confirm the constitutional powers of the bodies corporate controlling those institutions of higher education named in sections 4, 5, and 6 of article 8 of the state constitution of 1963, or established by law as therein provided, regarding the establishment and financing of student loan programs,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 390.1355).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 5. Whether or not notes or bonds issued pursuant to  
2 this act are WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF negotiable instruments
