SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 734

(As Passed the Senate November 9, 1999) (As amended by the House September 27, 2000)

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act,"

by amending section 4d (MCL 205.94d), as amended by 1992 PA 267.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- **1** Sec. 4d. (1) The tax levied under this act does not apply
- 2 to a purchase of a prescription drug for human use or food for
- 3 human consumption; to the deposit on a returnable container for a
- 4 beverage or the deposit on a carton or case that is used for
- 5 returnable containers; [TO NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND PREPARED FOOD
- 6 INTENDED FOR IMMEDIATE CONSUMPTION PROVIDED DURING WORK HOURS FOR
- 7 FREE OR AT A REDUCED RATE TO EMPLOYEES OF FOOD SERVICE
- 8 ESTABLISHMENTS LICENSED BY THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE;] to food or tangi-
- 9 ble personal property purchased with federal food stamps; or to
- 10 fruit or vegetable seeds and fruit or vegetable plants if
- 11 purchased at a place of business authorized to accept food stamps
