

SENATE BILL NO. 211

(As amended, May 12, 1999)

February 2, 1999, Introduced by Senators STEIL and SCHUETTE
and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1310.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1** SEC. 1310. (1) THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE ARE ENCOURAGED
2 TO ADOPT POLICIES TO REQUIRE PUPILS TO WEAR SCHOOL UNIFORMS AT
3 SCHOOL AND SCHOOL-RELATED FUNCTIONS.

(2) THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE ARE ENCOURAGED TO FOSTER
AN ENVIRONMENT INVOLVING ETHICAL CONDUCT AND CITIZENSHIP.

(3) THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE ARE ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE
INSTRUCTION IN ETHICS AND CITIZENSHIP WHENEVER RELEVANT TO THE
SUBJECT MATTER OF A CLASS.

(4) THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE ARE ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE
ANTI-VIOLENCE EDUCATION AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS THAT REDUCE
THE INCIDENCE OF VIOLENCE.
