HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 385

(As passed the House, January 26, 2000)

A bill to prohibit state agencies and local governmental units from disclosing personal information and placing personal information on certain documents.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Local governmental unit" means a school district,
3 intermediate school district, city, village, township, county,
4 authority, or other political subdivision of this state.

5 (b) "Person" means an individual, corporation, partnership,
6 association, governmental entity, or any other legal entity.

7 (c) "Personal information" means 1 or more of the
8 following:

9 (i) Social security number.

10 (ii) Driver license number.

1 (iii) State identification number.

2 (d) "State agency" means a department, board, commission,
3 office, agency, authority, or other unit of state government in
4 the executive, legislative, or judicial branch.

5 Sec. 2. A state agency or a local governmental unit shall
6 not deliver or cause to be delivered an envelope or package on
7 the outside of which personal information is placed or on the
8 inside of which personal information is placed that is visible
9 from the outside of the envelope or package.
