SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 414

A bill to amend 1984 PA 218, entitled "Third party administrator act,"
(MCL 550.901 to 550.962) by adding section 33.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 33. (1) A TPA SHALL NOT ENTER INTO A SERVICE CONTRACT
- 2 TO ADMINISTER A PLAN UNLESS THE PLAN INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR THE
- 3 FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, AND EDUCATIONAL TRAINING FOR THE
- 4 TREATMENT OF DIABETES, IF PRESCRIBED BY AN ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEO-
- 5 PATHIC PHYSICIAN:
- 6 (A) BLOOD GLUCOSE MONITORS AND BLOOD GLUCOSE MONITORS FOR
- 7 THE LEGALLY BLIND.
- 8 (B) TEST STRIPS FOR GLUCOSE MONITORS, VISUAL READING AND
- 9 URINE TESTING STRIPS, LANCETS, AND SPRING-POWERED LANCET
- 10 DEVICES.

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- 1 (C) INSULIN.
- 2 (D) MECHANICAL INJECTION AIDS.
- 3 (E) CARTRIDGES FOR THE LEGALLY BLIND.
- 4 (F) SYRINGES.
- 5 (G) INSULIN PUMPS AND APPURTENANCES THERETO.
- 6 (H) INSULIN INFUSION DEVICES.
- 7 (I) ORAL AGENTS FOR CONTROLLING BLOOD SUGAR AND OTHER MEDI-
- 8 CATIONS IF FILLED BY A PHARMACIST.
- 9 (J) DIABETES SELF-MANAGEMENT TRAINING TO ENSURE THAT PERSONS
- 10 WITH DIABETES ARE TRAINED AS TO THE PROPER SELF-MANAGEMENT AND
- 11 TREATMENT OF THEIR DIABETIC CONDITION, INCLUDING INFORMATION ON
- 12 MEDICAL NUTRITION THERAPY.
- 13 (2) A TPA SHALL NOT ENTER INTO A SERVICE CONTRACT TO ADMIN-
- 14 ISTER A PLAN UNLESS THE PLAN INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR THE FOLLOWING
- 15 EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, AND EDUCATIONAL TRAINING FOR THE TREATMENT
- 16 OF DIABETES:
- 17 (A) MEDICATIONS PRESCRIBED BY A PODIATRIST AND USED IN THE
- 18 TREATMENT OF FOOT AILMENTS, INFECTIONS, AND OTHER MEDICAL CONDI-
- 19 TIONS OF THE FOOT, ANKLE, OR NAILS ASSOCIATED WITH DIABETES.
- 20 (B) DIABETES SELF-MANAGEMENT TRAINING PROVIDED BY A PODIA-
- 21 TRIST TO ENSURE THAT PERSONS WITH DIABETES ARE TRAINED AS TO THE
- 22 PROPER SELF-MANAGEMENT AND TREATMENT OF THEIR DIABETIC CONDITION
- 23 RELATED TO CONDITIONS OF THE FOOT, ANKLE, AND NAILS ATTRIBUTABLE
- 24 TO DIABETES.
- 25 (3) COVERAGE UNDER THIS SECTION FOR SELF-MANAGEMENT TRAINING
- 26 AND MEDICAL NUTRITION THERAPY TRAINING IS SUBJECT TO ALL OF THE
- 27 FOLLOWING:

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- (A) IS LIMITED TO 1 ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN OR
- 2 PODIATRIST VISIT OR COMPLETION OF A CERTIFIED DIABETES EDUCATION
- 3 PROGRAM UPON EACH OCCURRENCE OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (i) IF CONSIDERED MEDICALLY NECESSARY UPON THE DIAGNOSIS OF
- 5 DIABETES BY AN ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN.
- (ii) IF AN ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN DIAGNOSES A
- 7 SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN THE PATIENT'S SYMPTOMS OR CONDITIONS THAT
- 8 NECESSITATES CHANGES IN A PATIENT'S SELF-MANAGEMENT OR A SIGNIFI-
- 9 CANT CHANGE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOL OR TREATMENT MODALITIES.
- (iii) IF REEDUCATION OR REFRESHER TRAINING IS NECESSARY AND 10
- 11 IS PRESCRIBED BY AN ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN.
- 12 (B) MAY BE PROVIDED BY THE ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEOPATHIC PHYSI-
- 13 CIAN AS PART OF AN OFFICE VISIT FOR DIABETES DIAGNOSIS OR
- **14** TREATMENT.
- (C) MAY BE PROVIDED BY A DIABETES OUTPATIENT TRAINING PRO-15
- 16 GRAM CERTIFIED TO RECEIVE MEDICAID OR MEDICARE REIMBURSEMENT OR
- 17 CERTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH. TRAINING PRO-
- 18 VIDED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION MAY BE LIMITED TO GROUP SETTINGS
- 19 WHENEVER PRACTICABLE.
- (D) INCLUDES HOME VISITS IF MEDICALLY NECESSARY AND PRE-20
- 21 SCRIBED BY AN ALLOPATHIC OR OSTEOPATHIC PHYSICIAN.
- (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DIABETES" INCLUDES ALL OF THE 22
- 23 FOLLOWING:
- 24 (A) GESTATIONAL DIABETES.
- 25 (B) INSULIN-USING DIABETES.
- (C) NON-INSULIN-USING DIABETES. 26
