## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 658

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1704.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1704. (1) THIS SECTION SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED
- 2 AS THE "BLIND PUPIL'S BRAILLE LITERACY LAW".
- 3 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT BRAILLE READING AND WRITING
- 4 STANDARDS FOR TEACHERS OF BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED PUPILS AND
- 5 SHALL DISSEMINATE THESE STANDARDS TO ALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS, INTER-
- 6 MEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAMS.
- 7 THESE STANDARDS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE RULES GOVERNING SPECIAL
- 8 EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES. IN ESTABLISHING THESE STAN-
- 9 DARDS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSIDER THE STANDARDS ADOPTED BY THE
