**SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 1184**

(As Passed the Senate May 31, 2000)

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 2b to chapter IV.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER IV

SEC. 2B. (1) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF AN ADJACENT STATE
HAS THE SAME AUTHORITY AND IMMUNITY AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
OF THIS STATE AS PROVIDED BY LAW IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDI-
TIONS ARE MET:

(A) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ARREST A
PERSON, WITH OR WITHOUT A WARRANT, FOR A VIOLATION OF A PENAL
STATUTE OR LAW IN THE ADJACENT STATE.

(B) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS ON DUTY AS A LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE ADJACENT STATE.

1 (C) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER NOTIFIES A LAW ENFORCEMENT
2 OFFICER OR AGENCY OF THIS STATE THAT HE OR SHE IS IN THIS STATE
3 AND 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:

4 (i) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS ENGAGED IN PURSUING,
5 ARRESTING, OR ATTEMPTING TO ARREST AN INDIVIDUAL FOR A VIOLATION
6 OF A LAW IN THE ADJACENT STATE.

7 (ii) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS IN THIS STATE AT THE
8 REQUEST OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THIS STATE.

9 (iii) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS WORKING IN CONJUNCTION
10 WITH A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THIS STATE.

11 (iv) THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS RESPONDING TO AN
12 EMERGENCY.

13 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

14 (A) "ADJACENT STATE" MEANS INDIANA, OHIO, MINNESOTA, OR
15 WISCONSIN.

16 (B) "EMERGENCY" MEANS A SUDDEN OR UNEXPECTED CIRCUMSTANCE
17 THAT REQUIRES IMMEDIATE ACTION TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY,
18 WELFARE, OR PROPERTY OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM ACTUAL OR THREATENED
19 HARM OR FROM AN UNLAWFUL ACT.

20 (C) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THIS STATE" MEANS A LAW
21 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE COMMISSION ON
22 LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS ACT, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.602.
