- 3 CUSTOMER SHALL NOT EXCEED 36 HOURS FOR ANY GIVEN MONTH.
- 4 (2) A PROVIDER OF BASIC LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE SHALL FILE A
- 5 REPORT WITH THE COMMISSION BY THE FIFTH DAY OF ANY MONTH THAT THE
- 6 AVERAGE RESPONSE TIME TO A SERVICE OUTAGE REPORT FROM A CUSTOMER
- 7 FOR THE PRECEDING MONTH EXCEEDS 36 HOURS.
- 8 (3) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTIES ALLOWED UNDER THIS
- 9 SECTION OR ACT, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING A PROVIDER THAT VIOLATES
- 10 SUBSECTION (1) MAY BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$1,000,000.00 BY THE
