**ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5996**

AN ACT to name a certain portion of highway M-59 and a certain portion of highway M-36 the "Korean War 50th Anniversary Memorial Highway"; and to prescribe certain duties of the state transportation department.

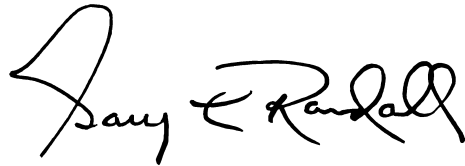
*The People of the State of Michigan enact:*

Sec. 1. (1) That portion of highway M-59 beginning at the county line of Livingston and Oakland counties and extending west to termination shall be named the "Korean War 50th Anniversary Memorial Highway".

(2) That portion of highway M-36 beginning at the eastern border of the township of Hamburg and ending at the western border of the village of Pinckney shall be named the "Korean War 50th Anniversary Memorial Highway".

Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall only provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the names of the highways when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting those markers.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
