- 4 (A) The death of the incumbent. ; his
- 5 (B) HIS OR HER resignation. ; his
- 6 (C) HIS OR HER removal from office. -; his-
- 7 (D) HIS OR HER ceasing to be an inhabitant of the district
- 8 for FROM which he shall have been OR SHE WAS elected. ; the
- 9 (E) THE decision of a competent tribunal declaring void his
- 10 OR HER election or appointment. -; or his-

- 1 (F) HIS OR HER refusal or neglect to take and subscribe to
- 2 his OR HER oath of office.
- **3** (G) THE EXPIRATION OF 7 DAYS AFTER THE STATE SENATOR OR
- 4 STATE REPRESENTATIVE HAS BEEN CERTIFIED AS BEING ELECTED TO AN
- 5 OFFICE IN THE OPPOSITE CHAMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE.
- 6 (2) Regardless of any change in the boundaries of any state
- 7 senatorial or representative district, an incumbent state senator
- 8 or representative shall continue to represent the district from
- 9 which he OR SHE was elected until his OR HER current term of
- 10 office shall expire EXPIRES or his OR HER successor is elected
- 11 and qualified.
