

# HOUSE BILL No. 4111

January 28, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Bishop, Pappageorge, Sanborn, Bovin, Richner, Kowall and Kukuk and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 29 to chapter IX.

## **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

### CHAPTER IX

2           SEC. 29. (1) IF A DEFENDANT IS SENTENCED TO IMPRISONMENT IN  
3 A JAIL FOR A PRIOR CONVICTION WHEN HE OR SHE IS SENTENCED FOR  
4 COMMITTING A MISDEMEANOR, THE COURT MAY ORDER ANY TERM OF IMPRIS-  
5 ONMENT FOR THE MISDEMEANOR CONVICTION TO RUN CONSECUTIVELY TO THE  
6 TERM OF IMPRISONMENT THE DEFENDANT IS SERVING AT THE TIME OF  
7 SENTENCING.  
8           (2) IF THE COURT SENTENCES A DEFENDANT TO TERMS OF IMPRISON-  
9 MENT FOR 2 OR MORE MISDEMEANORS, THE COURT MAY IMPOSE THE LONGEST  
10 TERM OF IMPRISONMENT TO BE SERVED CONSECUTIVELY TO AND PRECEDING  
11 THE NEXT LONGEST TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED. ALL OTHER TERMS

1 OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED FOR ANY REMAINING MISDEMEANORS SHALL BE  
2 SERVED CONCURRENTLY WITH THE LONGEST TERM OF IMPRISONMENT.
