A bill to regulate benefits provided to certain public employee retirement system participants in this state; and to prescribe powers and duties of certain retirement systems, state departments, public officials, and public employees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 (4) "Retirement system" means a public employee retirement

- 4 Sec. 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,

- 6 effective date of this act, a retirement system shall not use the
- 7 final compensation of a participant to calculate the
- 8 participant's benefit as a retirant under the retirement system,
- 9 unless the participant has received that final compensation
- 10 amount for a period of 6 months or more before the effective date
