THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) A person is eligible to become a corpsmember if 2 he or she:
- 3 (a) Is a resident of this state.
- 4 (b) Except for supervisors, is not EITHER OF THE
- 5 FOLLOWING:
- $\mathbf{6}$ (i) NOT less than 18 years of age and not more than 25 years
- 7 of age on the date of application.
- 8 (ii) FIFTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER ON THE DATE OF
- 9 APPLICATION.
- (c) Is not employed at the time of hire.

- 1 (d) Is not a son or daughter of an elected or appointed
- 2 official of this state or of a city, village, county, township,
- 3 school district, intermediate school district, or other govern-

- 5 (e) If employed as a supervisor, was not on the department's
- 6 or recipient's payroll within 30 days before being hired through
- 7 a program established with funds received under this act unless
