- 1 SEC. 18826. (1) A VETERINARIAN OR VETERINARY TECHNICIAN IS
- 2 NOT LIABLE FOR CIVIL DAMAGES AS A RESULT OF THE ACTS OR OMISSIONS
- 3 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) IF BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 4 (A) THE ANIMAL HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO THE VETERINARIAN OR VET-
- 5 ERINARY TECHNICIAN BY A PERSON OTHER THAN THE OWNER OF THE
- 6 ANIMAL.
- 7 (B) THE VETERINARIAN OR VETERINARY TECHNICIAN DOES NOT KNOW
- 8 WHO OWNS THE ANIMAL OR IS UNABLE TO CONTACT THE OWNER OF THE
- 9 ANIMAL BEFORE A DECISION MUST BE MADE WITH RESPECT TO EMERGENCY
- 10 TREATMENT OR EUTHANASIA.
