

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4863**

September 28, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Cassis, Vear, Bishop, Birkholz, Rick Johnson, Patterson, Sanborn and Richner and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act," (MCL 205.91 to 205.111) by adding section 4u.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- (1) THE TAX UNDER THIS ACT DOES NOT APPLY TO THE 1 SEC. 4U.
- 2 STORAGE, USE, OR CONSUMPTION OF INVESTMENT COINS AND BULLION.
- 3 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 4 (A) "BULLION" MEANS GOLD, SILVER, OR PLATINUM IN A BULK
- 5 STATE, WHERE ITS VALUE DEPENDS ON ITS CONTENT RATHER THAN ITS
- 6 FORM, WITH A PURITY OF NOT LESS THAN 900 PARTS PER 1,000.
- (B) "INVESTMENT COINS" MEANS NUMISMATIC COINS OR OTHER FORMS
- 8 OF MONEY AND LEGAL TENDER MANUFACTURED OF GOLD, SILVER, PLATINUM,
- 9 PALLADIUM, OR OTHER METAL AND ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES
- 10 GOVERNMENT OR A FOREIGN GOVERNMENT WITH A FAIR MARKET VALUE
- 11 GREATER THAN THE FACE VALUE OF THE COINS.
