

HOUSE BILL No. 5049

October 26, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Rivet, Woodward, Schauer, Pestka and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Operations.

A bill to create the quality government and accountability committee within the legislative branch; to prescribe its membership, powers, and duties; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state officials and state agencies.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "quality government and
- 2 accountability committee" or "committee" means the quality gov-
- 3 ernment and accountability committee created in section 3.
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) The quality government and accountability com-
- 5 mittee is created within the legislative branch. The committee
- 6 shall be bipartisan and consist of all of the following:
- 7 (a) Two members of the house of representatives appointed by
- 8 the speaker of the house of representatives.

- **9** (b) Two members of the house of representatives appointed by
- 10 the minority leader of the house of representatives.

- 1 (c) Two members of the senate appointed by the senate
- 2 majority leader.
- 3 (d) Two members of the senate appointed by the minority
- 4 leader of the senate.
- 5 (2) Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original
- 6 appointments. Members shall serve terms concurrent with their
- 7 term in the legislature and until their successors are appointed
- 8 and qualified. Members of the committee may be reimbursed for
- 9 expenses incurred in the administration of their duties.
- 10 (3) Annually the committee shall elect from its membership a
- 11 chairperson and alternate chairperson who shall be from different
- 12 houses. The position of chairperson shall alternate between the
- 13 senate and the house of representatives.
- 14 (4) The business that the committee may perform shall be
- 15 conducted at a public meeting of the committee held in compliance
- 16 with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 17 Public notice of the time, date, and place of the meeting shall
- 18 be given in the manner required by the open meetings act, 1976
- 19 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 20 (5) The committee shall meet not less than 3 times per
- 21 year. Special meetings shall be held on call of the chairperson
- 22 or a majority of the members of the committee. The committee
- 23 shall prescribe rules for its own procedure. A majority of the
- 24 committee constitutes a quorum, but a smaller number may transact
- 25 routine business. A majority of the committee shall concur in
- 26 any recommendation of the committee.

- 1 (6) The chairperson of the committee or a member designated
- 2 by the chairperson, upon majority vote of the committee, may
- 3 administer oaths, subpoena witnesses, and examine books and
- 4 records of a person, partnership, or corporation involved in a
- 5 matter properly before the committee.
- **6** (7) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of,
- 7 or retained by the committee in the performance of an official
- 8 function shall be made available to the public in compliance with
- 9 the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to
- **10** 15.246.
- 11 Sec. 5. The committee shall investigate, monitor, and
- 12 review all aspects of state government to promote quality govern-
- 13 ment and make state government accountable to the citizens of
- 14 this state. The committee shall do all of the following:
- 15 (a) Annually review and approve audit and operation plans
- 16 for the auditor general.
- 17 (b) Review all 1-year, 5-year, and 10-year strategic plans
- 18 of all state departments.
- 19 (c) Review performance audits of the auditor general.
- 20 (d) Review quality reports on performance audit responses
- 21 from the office of strategic planning.
- (e) Not less than annually report its findings and recom-
- 23 mmendations to the legislature and the governor.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
- 25 all of the following bills of the 90th Legislature are enacted
- 26 into law:
