A bill to designate the part of highway I-69 that is located between exit 94 and exit 105 as the "Purple Heart Highway"; and to prescribe the duties of the state transportation department.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The part of highway I-69 that is located between
- 2 exit 94 and exit 105 shall be known as the "Purple Heart
- 3 Highway".
- 4 Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall only pro-
- 5 vide for the erection of suitable markers, which identify the
- 6 name of that part of the highway at the approaches to the part of
- 7 the highway described in section 1 when sufficient private con-
- 8 tributions are received to pay the cost of erecting those
- 9 markers.
