

HOUSE BILL No. 5185

December 9, 1999, Introduced by Reps. O'Neil, DeRossett, Howell and Jamnick and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 53, entitled

"An act to prohibit access to computers, computer systems, and computer networks for certain fraudulent purposes; to prohibit intentional and unauthorized access, alteration, damage, and destruction of computers, computer systems, computer networks, computer software programs, and data; and to prescribe penalties,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 752.796), as amended by 1996 PA 326.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) A person shall not utilize USE a computer
- 2 program, computer, computer system, or computer network to commit
- 3 OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT a crime.
- 4 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM BEING
- 5 CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION
- 6 OF LAW COMMITTED BY THAT PERSON WHILE VIOLATING OR ATTEMPTING TO
- 7 VIOLATE THIS SECTION, INCLUDING THE UNDERLYING OFFENSE.
