



HOUSE BILL No. 5224

January 19, 2000, Introduced by Reps. A bill to supplement appropriations for the department of education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriation; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

PART 1

LINE-ITEM APPROPRIATIONS

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of education to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, from the following funds:

PART 2

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for fiscal year 1999-2000 is \$50,000.00. State payments to local units of government under this act are \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriation made and the expenditure authorized under this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 301. The funds appropriated under this act shall be expended to create a toll-free hotline through the collaboration of the department of education with the department of state police that will operate 7 days per week, 24 hours per day. The toll-free hotline shall provide students, school officials, and other individuals an opportunity to report specific threats of imminent school violence or to report other suspicious or criminal conduct by juveniles to appropriate state and local law enforcement entities for investigation.
