

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5244**

February 1, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Thomas, Schauer, Hale, Bogardus, Scott, Schermesser, DeHart, Jacobs, Brater, Minore, Dennis and Daniels and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

by amending section 21513 (MCL 333.21513), as amended by 1993 PA 79.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 21513. (1) The owner, operator, and governing body of
- 2 a hospital licensed under this article:
- 3 (a) Are responsible for all phases of the operation of the
- 4 hospital, selection of the medical staff, and quality of care
- 5 rendered in the hospital.
- 6 (b) Shall cooperate with the department in the enforcement
- 7 of this part, and require that the physicians, dentists, and
- 8 other personnel working in the hospital and for whom a license or
- 9 registration is required be currently licensed or registered.

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- 1 (c) Shall assure that physicians and dentists admitted to
- 2 practice in the hospital are granted hospital privileges
- 3 consistent with their individual training, experience, and other
- 4 qualifications.
- 5 (d) Shall assure that physicians and dentists admitted to
- 6 practice in the hospital are organized into a medical staff to
- 7 enable an effective review of the professional practices in the
- 8 hospital for the purpose of reducing morbidity and mortality and
- 9 improving the care provided in the hospital for patients. This
- 10 review shall include the quality and necessity of the care pro-
- 11 vided and the preventability of complications and deaths occur-
- 12 ring in the hospital.
- 13 (e) After December 31, 1989, shall not discriminate because
- 14 of race, religion, color, national origin, age, or sex in the
- 15 operation of the hospital including employment, patient admission
- 16 and care, room assignment, and professional or nonprofessional
- 17 selection and training programs, and shall not discriminate in
- 18 the selection and appointment of individuals to the physician
- 19 staff of the hospital or its training programs on the basis of
- 20 licensure or registration or professional education as doctors of
- 21 medicine, osteopathic medicine and surgery, or podiatry.
- 22 (f) Shall assure that the hospital adheres to medical con-
- 23 trol authority protocols according to section 20918 20919.
- 24 (2) BEGINNING 1 YEAR AFTER THE MAY 15 FOLLOWING THE EFFEC-
- 25 TIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 26 GOVERNING BODY OF A HOSPITAL LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL
- 27 PREPARE AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC, UPON REQUEST AND AT NO

- 1 CHARGE, NO LATER THAN MAY 15 OF EACH YEAR AN ANNUAL COMMUNITY
- 2 RESPONSIBILITY REPORT THAT SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 3 INFORMATION:
- 4 (A) A DESCRIPTION OF THE COMMUNITY SERVED BY THE HOSPITAL.
- 5 (B) A DESCRIPTION OF THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE GOVERNING
- 6 BODY TO THE COMMUNITY SERVED BY THE HOSPITAL.
- 7 (C) A SUMMARY OF THE ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE HOSPITAL AND THE
- 8 GOVERNING BODY TO FULFILL THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE GOVERNING
- 9 BODY TO THE COMMUNITY SERVED BY THE HOSPITAL.
- 10 (D) A BALANCE SHEET AND INCOME STATEMENT FOR THE HOSPITAL AT
- 11 THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON THE PRECEDING DECEMBER 31 OR LAST DAY OF
- 12 THE HOSPITAL'S FISCAL YEAR.
- 13 (E) THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF EACH MEMBER
- 14 OF THE GOVERNING BODY.
