



HOUSE BILL No. 5330

February 9, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Frank, Neumann, Pestka, Bob Brown, Kelly, Prusi, Cherry, O'Neil, Spade, Mans, Price, Martinez, Bogardus and Hale and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for the department of state police for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

PART 1

LINE-ITEM APPROPRIATIONS

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of state police for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, from the following funds:

PART 2

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for fiscal year 1999-2000 is \$1,200,000.00. State payments to local units of government under this act are \$0.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and the expenditures authorized under this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

STATE POLICE

Sec. 301. The funds appropriated to the department of state police shall be used to provide an internet crime unit within the department.
