A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for the department of state police for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations.

3 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

- 4 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state consti-
- 5 tution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for fiscal year
- 6 2000-2001 is \$1,300,000.00. State payments to local units of government
- 7 under this act are \$0.
- 8 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and the expenditures authorized
- 9 under this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards,
- 10 offices, and programs for which an appropriation is made under this act
- 11 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to
- **12** 18.1594.

13 STATE POLICE

- 14 Sec. 301. The department shall establish and maintain an internet
- 15 crime unit within the department. The money appropriated in this act
- 16 shall be expended for wages, salaries, and equipment utilized to investi-
- 17 gate crimes committed through the use of the Internet.
- 18 Sec. 302. The personnel assigned to the internet crime unit shall
- 19 include the following:
- 20 (a) Seven detective sergeants.
- 21 (b) Four forensic information tech specialists.
- (c) One clerical.
