



# HOUSE BILL No. 5514

March 16, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Stallworth, Kelly, LaForge, Frank, Pestka, Rick Johnson, Daniels, Scranton, Mead, Pumford, Kilpatrick, Byl, Cherry, Tesanovich and Price and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 16n of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16n), as added  
by 1998 PA 317.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 16n. This chapter applies to the following felonies  
enumerated in chapter 750 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
