



HOUSE BILL No. 5628

April 18, 2000, Introduced by Rep. Bishop and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending sections 503 and 504 (MCL 750.503 and 750.504).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 503. ~~Punishment of felonies when not fixed by~~
2 ~~statute--A~~ IF A person IS convicted of ~~a crime declared in this~~
3 ~~or any other act of the state of Michigan, to be a felony ,~~
4 for which no ~~other~~ punishment is specially prescribed, ~~by any~~
