



HOUSE BILL No. 5652

April 18, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Dennis, Callahan, O'Neil, Van Woerkom, Wojno, Rivet, Pestka, Neumann, Frank, Jamnick, Minore and Lockwood and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 5a to chapter IX.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER IX

SEC. 5A. IF A PERSON IS SENTENCED TO SERVE A TERM OF
IMPRISONMENT FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING VIOLATIONS AND THE VIOLA-
TION INVOLVED THE OPERATION OF A VEHICLE, THE COURT MAY ORDER THE
TERM OF IMPRISONMENT TO BE SERVED CONSECUTIVELY TO ANY TERM OF
IMPRISONMENT FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION ARISING OUT OF THE SAME OR A
DIFFERENT CRIMINAL TRANSACTION:

(A) SECTION 602A(5), 617, 625(4), OR 904(4) OF THE MICHIGAN
VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.602A, 257.617, 257.625, AND
257.904, REGARDING FLEEING AND ELUDING CAUSING DEATH, LEAVING THE

1 SCENE OF A FATAL ACCIDENT, DRUNK DRIVING CAUSING DEATH, OR
2 DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED CAUSING DEATH.

3 (B) SECTION 316, 317, 322, 324, OR 479A(5) OF THE MICHIGAN
4 PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.316, 750.317, 750.322, 750.324,
5 AND 750.479A, REGARDING FIRST DEGREE MURDER, SECOND DEGREE
6 MURDER, MANSLAUGHTER, NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE, OR FLEEING AND ELUDING
7 CAUSING DEATH.
