

HOUSE BILL No. 5658

April 18, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Lemmons, O'Neil, DeHart, Rocca, Kilpatrick, Daniels, Cherry, Switalski, Jacobs, Spade, Tabor, Mans, Bogardus, Richardville, Scott, Gieleghem, Neumann and Pappageorge and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 349b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 349B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 349 OR 349A IS
- 2 GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR LIFE WITHOUT
- 3 THE POSSIBILITY OF PAROLE IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 4 (A) THE VICTIM OF THE KIDNAPPING IS A MINOR.
- 5 (B) DURING THE COURSE OF THE KIDNAPPING, THE PERSON COMMITS
- 6 A SEXUAL ASSAULT OR OTHER ACT AGAINST THAT MINOR THAT IS PRO-
- 7 SCRIBED IN SECTION 145(2), 157C, 520B, 520C, 520D, 520E, OR 520G.
- **8** Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
- 9 effect unless Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 5659
- 10 (request no. 05517'99 a) of the 90th Legislature is enacted into

11 law.
