

HOUSE BILL No. 5960

September 26, 2000, Introduced by Rep. Hanley and referred to the Committee on Constitutional Law and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending sections 53, 54, 93, 94, 133, 134, 163, 164, 193,
194, 224, 225, 254, 256, 322, 322a, 349, and 351 (MCL 168.53,
168.54, 168.93, 168.94, 168.133, 168.134, 168.163, 168.164,
168.193, 168.194, 168.224, 168.225, 168.254, 168.256, 168.322,
168.322a, 168.349, and 168.351), sections 53, 163, 193, 224, 254,
322, and 349 as amended by 1999 PA 218, sections 93 and 133 as
amended by 1996 PA 583, and section 164 as amended by 1990 PA 7.
