A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 803j (MCL 257.803j), as amended by 1999 PA 183.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803j. (1) A person who was a member of the armed
- 2 services FORCES, or a person whose spouse was a member of the
- 3 armed forces, during the Korean War may make application to the
- 4 secretary of state for a special registration plate, which shall
- 5 display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration num-
- 6 bers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the reg-
- 7 istration numbers.
