

## **HOUSE BILL No. 6056**

October 3, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Gieleghem, Jacobs, Bovin and Wojno and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," by amending section 217b (MCL 750.217b), as added by 1997 PA 159.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 217b. (1) An individual who is not employed by THIS
- 2 STATE, A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, OR a public utility shall not
- 3 inform another individual or represent to another individual by
- 4 uniform, identification, or any other means that he or she is
- 5 employed by that THIS STATE, A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, OR A
- 6 public utility with intent to do 1 or more of the following:
- 7 (a) Gain or attempt to gain entry to a residence, building,
- 8 structure, facility, or other property.

- (b) Remain or attempt to remain in or upon a residence,
- 10 building, structure, facility, or other property.

- 1 (c) Commit or attempt to commit a crime.
- 2 (2) An individual who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
- 3 felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a
- 4 fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 5 (3) As used in this section, "public utility" means a util-
- 6 ity that provides steam, gas, heat, electricity, water, cable
- 7 television, telecommunications services, or pipeline services,
- 8 whether privately, municipally, or cooperatively owned.
