

**SENATE BILL NO. 66**

January 26, 1999, Introduced by Senator GAST and referred to the  
Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of agriculture for  
the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000; to provide for the expenditure  
of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and  
other income received by various agencies.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of agriculture  
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, from the following funds:

2 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of  
3 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from  
4 state resources in this appropriations act for the fiscal year ending

7 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under  
8 this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs  
9 for which appropriations are made under this act are subject to the man-
