THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 10 EXHIBITIONS. A MANAGER, PROMOTER, MATCHMAKER, TRAINER, OR BOXER

- 1 PARTICIPATING IN THE BOXING OR SPARRING MATCH OR EXHIBITION IS
- 2 CONSIDERED TO HAVE A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN THAT MATCH OR

- (C) PARTICIPATES, IN ANY MANNER, IN ANY BOXING OR SPARRING

- (2) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD WHO IS A MEMBER OF A BOXING CLUB

- (3) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL NOT REPRESENT TO A PERSON
- 10 THAT HE OR SHE IS ACTING FOR OR REPRESENTING THE BOARD UNLESS HE
- 11 OR SHE HAS FIRST OBTAINED AUTHORITY FROM THE BOARD TO SO ACT OR

- (4) A PERSON IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A LICENSE AS A PROMOTER OR 13
- 14 MATCHMAKER FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR AFTER CEASING TO BE A MEMBER OF
