

**SENATE BILL NO. 246**

February 3, 1999, Introduced by Senators SHUGARS, STEIL, GOUGEON and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled  
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"  
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 904.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 904. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT CONSUME OR POSSESS ALCO-  
2 HOLIC LIQUOR ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.

3           (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDE-  
4 MEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 120 DAYS OR A  
5 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$200.00, OR BOTH.

6           (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE CONSUMPTION OR POS-  
7 SESSION OF AN ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AS PART OF A GENERALLY RECOGNIZED  
8 RELIGIOUS SERVICE ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.

9           (4) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT AN INDIVIDUAL FROM BEING  
10 CONVICTED OF OR FOUND RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW

1 ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION AS THE VIOLATION OF THIS  
2 SECTION.

3 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

4 (A) "SCHOOL" MEANS A PUBLIC, PRIVATE, DENOMINATIONAL, OR  
5 PAROCHIAL SCHOOL OFFERING DEVELOPMENTAL KINDERGARTEN, KINDERGAR-  
6 TEN, OR ANY GRADE FROM 1 THROUGH 12.

7 (B) "SCHOOL PROPERTY" MEANS A BUILDING, PLAYING FIELD, OR  
8 PROPERTY USED FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES TO IMPART INSTRUCTION TO CHIL-  
9 DREN OR USED FOR FUNCTIONS AND EVENTS SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL,  
10 EXCEPT A BUILDING USED PRIMARILY FOR ADULT EDUCATION OR COLLEGE  
11 EXTENSION COURSES.
