

**SENATE BILL NO. 287**

February 9, 1999, Introduced by Senators VAN REGENMORTER,  
ROGERS, STEIL and BULLARD and referred to the Committee on  
Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 626c.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

- 1        SEC. 626C. (1) A PERSON WHO COMMITS 3 OR MORE OF THE FOL-  
2        LOWING DURING A SINGLE CONTINUOUS PERIOD OF DRIVING IS GUILTY OF  
3        AGGRESSIVE DRIVING:  
4        (A) RECKLESS DRIVING UNDER SECTION 626.  
5        (B) CARELESS DRIVING UNDER SECTION 626B.  
6        (C) VIOLATION OF A SPEED LIMIT ESTABLISHED UNDER  
7        SECTION 627, 627A, 628, OR 629.  
8        (D) FAILURE TO OBEY A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE AS PROVIDED IN  
9        SECTION 611.  
10       (E) FOLLOWING ANOTHER VEHICLE TOO CLOSELY AS DESCRIBED IN  
11       SECTION 643.

1       (F) OVERTAKING AND PASSING A VEHICLE ON THE RIGHT BY DRIVING  
2 OFF THE PAVEMENT OR MAIN-TRAVELED PORTION OF THE ROADWAY AS PRO-  
3 VIDED IN SECTION 637(2).

4       (G) FAILURE TO YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AS DESCRIBED IN  
5 SECTION 649.

6       (H) IMPROPER LANE CHANGES IN VIOLATION OF SECTION 642.

7       (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A  
8 CIVIL INFRACTION.
