- 8 750.316, AND 750.317, or a violation or attempted violation of
- 9 section 349, 520b, 520c, 520d, 520e, or 520g of Act No. 328 of
- 10 the Public Acts of 1931, being sections 750.349, 750.520b,
- 11 750.520c, 750.520d, 750.520e, and 750.520g of the Michigan
