- 16 GATE THE DELIVERY OF A PRESCRIPTION DRUG CONSISTING ONLY OF A
- 17 SINGLE DOSE OF METHADONE TO A REGISTERED CLIENT OF THE METHADONE
- 18 TREATMENT PROGRAM IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:
- 19 (A) THE DELIVERY IS DELEGATED TO 1 OF THE FOLLOWING

- 21 (i) A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSE OR A LICENSED PRACTICAL
