## SENATE BILL NO. 548

April 28, 1999, Introduced by Senator EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, International Trade and Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

- 21 SEMESTER HOURS IN THERAPEUTIC RECREATION AND 3 SEMESTER HOURS
