

SENATE BILL NO. 615

May 26, 1999, Introduced by Senators DINGELL, KOIVISTO and
PETERS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 416a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 416A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT PLACE ANY DEVICE ON OR IN
2 A VEHICLE THAT IS DESIGNED OR INTENDED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION
3 REGARDING THE VEHICLE'S LOCATION TO ANY PERSON WITHOUT THE KNOWL-
4 EDGE OF THE VEHICLE'S OWNER OR LEGAL OPERATOR. THIS SECTION DOES
5 NOT APPLY TO A PEACE OFFICER LAWFULLY PERFORMING HIS OR HER
6 DUTIES AS A PEACE OFFICER.
- 7 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
8 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF
9 NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 10 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PEACE OFFICER" MEANS 1 OR MORE
11 OF THE FOLLOWING:

1 (A) A POLICE OFFICER OF THIS STATE OR A POLITICAL
2 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.

3 (B) A POLICE OFFICER OF ANY ENTITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

4 (C) THE SHERIFF OF A COUNTY OF THIS STATE OR THE SHERIFF'S
5 DEPUTY.

6 (D) A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COLLEGE,
7 OR UNIVERSITY WHO IS AUTHORIZED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THAT
8 COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY TO ENFORCE STATE LAW
9 AND THE RULES AND ORDINANCES OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COLLEGE,
10 OR UNIVERSITY.

11 (E) A CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
12 RESOURCES OR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.

13 (F) A CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT
14 OF THE INTERIOR.
