

SENATE BILL No. 800

October 13, 1999, Introduced by Senator ROGERS and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 20912 (MCL 333.20912), as added by 1990 PA 179.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 20912. (1) The department shall perform all of the
2 following with regard to educational programs and services:

3 (a) Review and approve education programs and curricula for
4 emergency medical services personnel. Approved programs shall
5 have provisions for written and practical examinations and shall
6 be coordinated by a licensed emergency medical services
7 instructor-coordinator.

8 (b) Review and approve all ongoing education programs for
9 relicensure of emergency medical services personnel.

1 (c) Maintain a listing of approved emergency medical
2 education programs and licensed emergency medical services
3 instructor-coordinators.

4 (2) THE SAFE MICHIGAN FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
5 TREASURY.

6 (3) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
7 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
8 LIMITED TO, REVENUES RECEIVED UNDER SECTION 811D OF THE MICHIGAN
9 VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.811D. THE STATE TREASURER
10 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
11 SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND
12 INVESTMENTS.

13 (4) MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL
14 REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

15 (5) THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DIVISION OF THE DEPART-
16 MENT OF CONSUMER AND INDUSTRY SERVICES SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM
17 THE FUND, UPON APPROPRIATION, ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING
18 ADDITIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
19 PERSONNEL.

20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
21 effect unless Senate Bill No. 799

22 of the 90th Legislature is enacted into law.
