December 9, 1999, Introduced by Senator BYRUM and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the department of natural resources to convey certain parcels of state owned property in Ingham county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyances; and to provide for disposition of the revenue from the conveyances.

- 9 of that use or use for any other purpose, the state may reenter
- 10 and repossess the property, terminating the grantee's estate in
- 11 the property.
- 12 (b) That if the grantee disputes the state's exercise of its
- 13 right of reentry and fails to promptly deliver possession of the
- 14 property to the state, the attorney general, on behalf of the
- 15 state, may bring an action to quiet title to, and regain posses-
- 16 sion of, the property.
- 17 Sec. 3. The descriptions contained in section 1 are approx-
- 18 imate and, for purposes of conveyance, may be adjusted by the
- 19 department of natural resources as necessary by survey or revised
- 20 legal description.
- 21 Sec. 4. The conveyances authorized by this act shall be by
- 22 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall not
- 23 reserve mineral rights to the state. However, the conveyances
- 24 shall provide that if the grantee develops the mineral rights,
- 25 the state shall receive not less than 1/2 of the net royalties
- 26 derived from that development.

- 1 Sec. 5. The revenue received from the conveyances under
- 2 this act shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to
- 3 the general fund.
