THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 or of an accident.
- 3 (c) Deliberately refusing or failing to disengage a connec-
- 4 tion between a telephone and another telephone or between a tele-

- 6 sages by telephone, thereby interfering with any communications
- 7 service.
- 8 (d) Using any vulgar, indecent, obscene, or offensive lan-

- 1 (2) Any A person violating this section may be imprisoned
- 2 for not more than 6 months, or fined not more than \$500.00, or
- 3 both. An offense is committed under this section if the communi-
- 4 cation either originates or terminates or both originates and
- 5 terminates in this state and may be prosecuted at the place of
- 6 origination or termination.
