## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 626b. (1) A person who operates a vehicle upon a
- 2 highway or a frozen public lake, stream, or pond or other place
- 3 open to the general public including an area designated for the
- 4 parking of vehicles in a careless or negligent manner likely to
- 5 endanger any person or property, but without wantonness or reck-
- 6 lessness, is responsible for a civil infraction.
- 7 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CARELESS OR NEGLIGENT MANNER"
- 8 INCLUDES THE USE OF A HANDHELD CELLULAR TELEPHONE THAT PREVENTS
- 9 THE PERSON FROM HAVING BOTH HANDS ON THE STEERING WHEEL OF THE
- 10 VEHICLE.
