- 2 (a) "Confidential information" means an individual's name,
- 3 address, social security number, telephone number, account number
- 4 at a financial institution, credit record, or investment record.
- 5 (b) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,

- (i) The sale of a good or service.
- (ii) The providing of credit to an individual.

- 1 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), a person shall not
- 2 do either of the following:

- 25 INSTITUTION, CREDIT RECORD, OR INVESTMENT RECORD. I UNDERSTAND
- 26 THAT MICHIGAN LAW PROHIBITS FROM REFUSING TO
- 27 PROVIDE A GOOD OR SERVICE OR TO EXTEND CREDIT TO ME SOLELY

- 1 BECAUSE I FAIL TO CONSENT TO THE WAIVER OF MY RIGHT TO KEEP
- 2 CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN THIS CONSENT FORM.
