

SENATE BILL No. 1176

March 23, 2000, Introduced by Senator JAYE and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled
"The social welfare act,"
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 57m.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 57M. (1) THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL NOT PRO-
2 VIDE EITHER CASH ASSISTANCE OR FOOD STAMPS TO AN APPLICANT WHO IS
3 REGISTERED OR REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER THE SEX OFFENDERS
4 REGISTRATION ACT, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 TO 28.732.

5 (2) IF THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY DETERMINES THAT A
6 RECIPIENT IS REGISTERED OR IS REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER THE
7 SEX OFFENDERS REGISTRATION ACT, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 TO
8 28.732, THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL STOP PROVIDING CASH
9 ASSISTANCE AND FOOD STAMPS TO THE RECIPIENT.
