- 4 FOR A PERIOD ENDING 3 YEARS AFTER THAT ENACTMENT DATE.
- 5 (2) AS USED IN THIS ACT:
- 6 (A) "ELECTRONIC COMMERCE" MEANS ANY TRANSACTION CONDUCTED
- 7 OVER THE INTERNET OR THROUGH INTERNET ACCESS THAT IS A SALE,
- 8 LEASE, LICENSE, OFFER, OR DELIVERY OF PROPERTY, GOODS, SERVICES,
- 9 OR INFORMATION, WHETHER OR NOT FOR CONSIDERATION.
- 10 (B) "INTERNET" MEANS COLLECTIVELY ANY OF THE COMPUTER OR
- 11 TELECOMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES, INCLUDING EQUIPMENT AND OPERATING
