A bill to amend 1917 PA 354, entitled

"An act to prohibit the practice of law by corporations and voluntary associations and to provide penalties for violations," by amending section 1 (MCL 450.681).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) It shall be unlawful for any A corporation or
- 2 voluntary association to SHALL NOT practice or appear as an
